Take home the lifelong skill of presenting yourself confidently as you are individually introduced on stage with all the lights, sounds, and excitement! This is your moment alone in the spotlight wearing the dress of your choice! Select a color and style that reflects your unique personality. Your dress should help you feel confident and excited!

The judges are looking for a representative who is proud and comfortable with who she is and how she presents herself on stage. Scores are based on the judges' overall impressions, and your ability to command both the judges' and the audience's attention in a poised, graceful, and professional manner. Keep in mind that all formal wear dresses should remain age appropriate. If there is a question in your mind if a dress is stepping over the line, be aware that one or more judges may have that same concern. Formal Wear counts for 25% of your total pageant score.

Princess, Little, and Junior:

- Select a formal dress that is appropriate for your age and personality.
 - The dress may be any length and any style.
 - No bare midriffs
- Shoes should be small heels or flats that complement the dress. Make sure you can walk confidently, smoothly, and safely in your shoes.
 - No noticeable makeup.
